


- These instructions are a model specific add-on to the general BoosterPlug installation instructions.
- The pictures below should help you locate the AIT sensor where the BoosterPlug is installed.
- Install the BoosterPlug module as per the general installation papers.
- The AIT sensor is located on the subframe below the dashboard
- The external sensor on the BoosterPlug is already in the right spot, so you just need to secure it with a zip-tie tp prevent it from flopping around.
